Here are details about September start-up next week: Staggered Entry

- Tuesday, September 5 **Grade 6s only attend 8:50 10:50 am (buses available in the morning, but not to return home at 10:50, so please make other arrangements).**
 - All staff will be outside to greet students and will direct students to a line on the side field. Students will line-up and will be greeted by their homeroom teacher. Their teacher will walk them to class at 8:50. Minimal supplies are needed (pen/pencil, paper). Thank you to the PAC who will also have a Welcome Table set-up for incoming Grade 6 families.
- Wednesday, September 6- Grade 7s only attend 8:50 10:50 am (buses available in the morning, but not to return home at 10:50, so please make other arrangements).
 - All staff will be outside to greet students and will direct students to a line on the side field. Students will line-up and will be greeted by their homeroom teacher. Their teacher will walk them to class at 8:50. Minimal supplies are needed (pen/pencil, paper).
- Wednesday, September 6 Grade 8s only attend 12:51 2:51 pm (no bus to get to school, but the buses are available to return students home at 2:51)
 - All staff will be outside to greet students and will direct students to a line on the side field. Students will line-up and will be greeted by their homeroom teacher. Their teacher will walk them to class at 8:50. Minimal supplies are needed (pen/pencil, paper).



Schedules and Class Placements

Please note, the process for class building and placement began last May and is a complicated process. It involves a lot of factors, such as peer groups and dynamics, learning styles and needs, class composition, numbers, etc. We gather input from teachers, support staff and parents at that time. We try to ensure our grade 6s are in class with students they know from their elementary schools and believe as students move up in grades they will have had the opportunity to make new friendships and be more comfortable at Spencer. Please note, we will not be accepting class change requests at this time. Having middle years children at home myself, I know how hard it may be for some students to see that they are not in class with their closest friends, however, it also offers them an opportunity to grow, develop and create new friendships. Thank you for understanding this process and understanding why we do not allow for class changes, unless we at the school need to make the change for operational purposes. Lastly, full student schedules are not reflected on MyEd yet and will be determined by the homeroom teacher. Students have only been scheduled into their homeroom/Exploratory or Band/PHE and sometimes French, depending on whether the homeroom teacher or partner teacher is their languages teacher.
